



SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 2017

INTRODUCED MARCH 25, 1971

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION ratifying a proposed amendment to the Constitution of the United States guaranteeing to persons 18 years of age and older the right to vote in Federal, State and local elections.

1 WHEREAS, By a joint resolution of the Congress of the United
2 States entitled "Joint resolution proposing an amendment to
3 the Constitution of the United States extending the right to vote
4 to citizens 18 years of age or older" adopted by the first session
5 of the Ninety-second Congress of the United States, the follow-
6 article was proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
7 the United States:

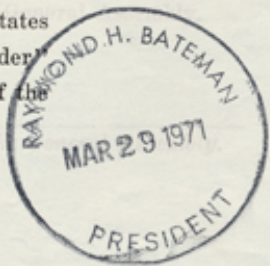
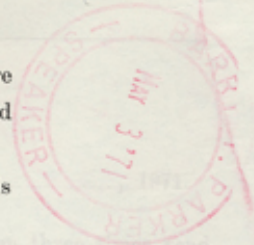
"ARTICLE . . .

8 "Section 1. The right of citizens of the United States, who are
9 18 years of age or older, to vote shall not be denied or abridged
10 by the United States or by any State on account of age.

11 "Section 2. The Congress shall have power to enforce this
12 article by appropriate legislation."

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of New Jersey (the
2 General Assembly concurring):

1 1. That the Legislature of the State of New Jersey, on behalf
2 of the State of New Jersey, does hereby ratify the proposed amend-
3 ment to the Constitution of the United States, which is set forth
4 in a joint resolution of the Congress entitled "Joint resolution
5 proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States
6 extending the right to vote to citizens 18 years of age or older"
7 adopted by the first session of the Ninety-second Congress of the



8 United States, and which is set forth in full in the preamble to
9 this concurrent resolution.

1 2. That the Secretary of State of the State of New Jersey be
2 and he is hereby directed to notify the Secretary of State of the
3 United States of the action taken by the Legislature of the State
4 of New Jersey with respect to said proposed amendment to the
5 Constitution of the United States.

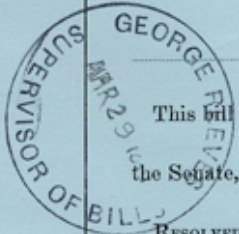
