Design Element: According to NJDEP iMap Landscape Project 2.1 database and the US Fish and Wildlife Service's (USFWS) municipality list includes the presence or possible presence of a number of state endangered and threatened plant and bird species which Parsons believes would require field studies or investigations that would have to be performed in order to address the federal and state requirements for permitting for this site. USACOE will not require any investigations for state listed species since they have no jurisdiction; however, the NJDEP will require further review or investigations for all species identified above. Both federal and state wetland permits will be required for this project.

Parsons has recommended conducting such additional investigation and fieldwork this year to conduct these studies to prevent delays in the wetland permit application process and in the project overall schedule. Parsons recommended the Natural Heritage request should be conducted immediately and USFWS should be notified to identify species within the study area.

Decision and reasoning:

It is noted, however, that on 9/1/10 NJDOT does not think any threatened and endangered species

or habitat are present. NJDOT has also instructed Parsons that it will provide specific direction in a few weeks.
