Elimination of the railroad line under the bridge is an important element of the preferred alternative. Also included are geometric improvements and four traffic signals along parallel service roads on both sides of Route 1 within the project limits. This project is being designed to be bicycle/pedestrian compatible. In addition, safety conditions will be improved for bicycle/pedestrians along College Farm Road and Access Road.
