Burlington County is expanding its Closed Loop Traffic Control System to include an additional 23 intersections in Hainesport, Lumberton, Moorestown, Mount Holly and Mount Laurel Townships. The bridge was constructed in 1968, and its deck condition should be reviewed. The guiderail along this section of Tuckahoe Road, particularly approaching the bridge, does not meet current standards. The guiderail will be updated as part of the project. At the intersection with Tyler Road, Tyler Road has limited sight distance in looking to the left along Tuckahoe Road and should be adjusted as part of the improvements.

This project is funded under the provisions of Section 13 of P.L. 1995, c.108. This is a multiyear funded Federal-aid construction project. Total Federal-aid needed for construction is anticipated to be \$10,000,000.
