

## TP-576 Presentation Questions and Answers

Q1. Can a Firm bring in twin monitors configured to their laptop to reduce potential technical issues.

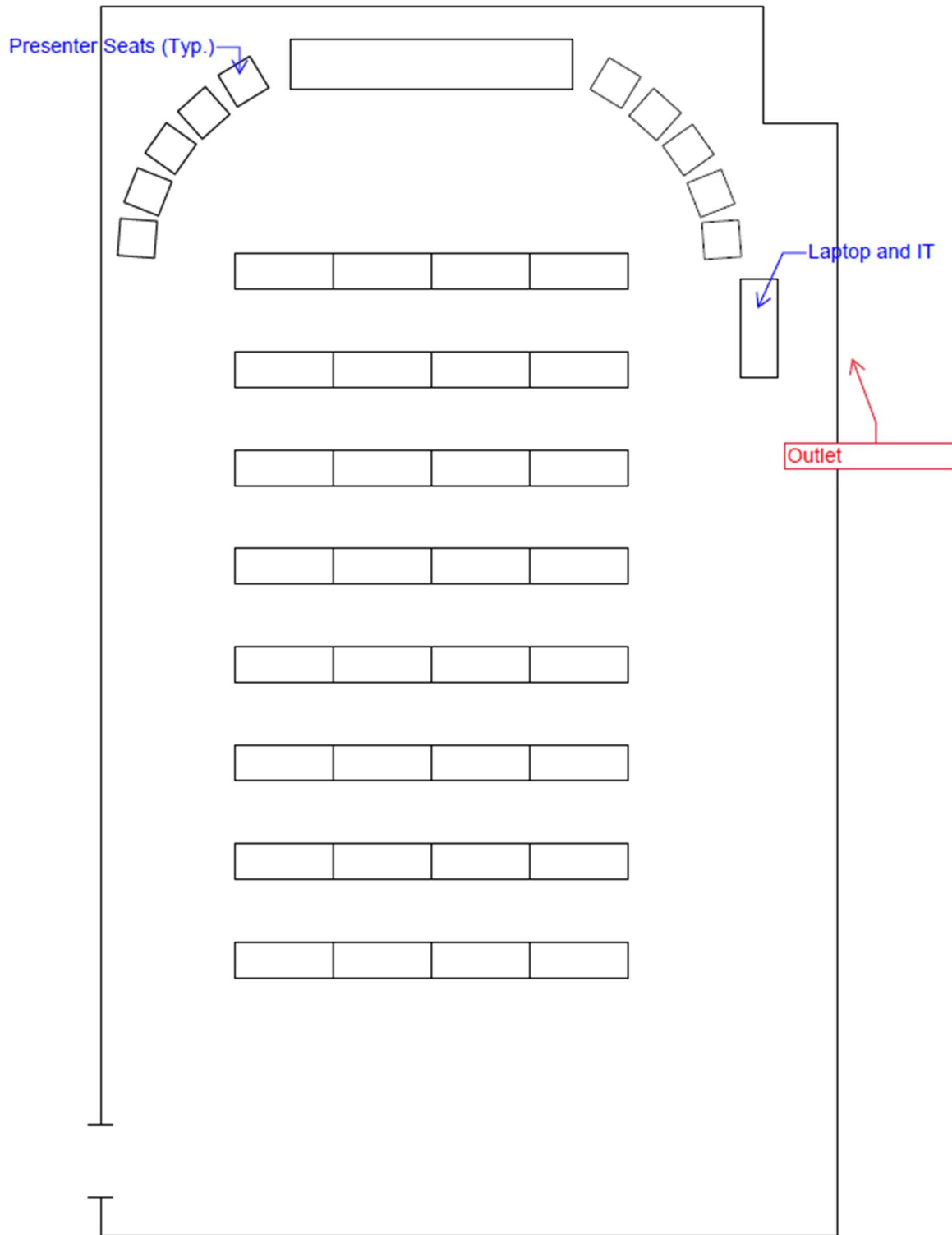
A1. Yes. If you are not bringing company monitors, projector, screen, etc., the room has one large monitor (image below). We recommend bringing a laptop to connect to the HDMI on the tv. IT does not allow external flash drives to be connected to DOT computers.
