This advisory serves to announce that effective April 4, 2016, there will no longer be a specific group of technicians that only perform electrical construction inspection. Inspectors who previously performed these duties will be assigned to a Construction project and will report to that project's RE or Field Manager. Project site inspection assignments will be made based on the Division's operational needs.

Each project's inspectors will be responsible for inspecting all elements of the construction included in the Contract Documents. Divisional employees will have the opportunity to gain technical knowledge and experience of various construction items as the Contract work progresses.

In addition to the training in the field, the technicians who previously performed electrical inspection will be provided access to the Construction Procedures Handbook, the 2007 Standard Specifications, the 2007 Road and Bridge Construction Details, other documents needed to perform these duties, and guidance from their respective RE and Field Manager.

Those engineers and technicians who did not formerly perform electrical inspection will be provided access to the 2007 Electrical Details, electrical inspection checklists, and given guidance from the Regional Electrical Engineers.
