Register the business with the New Jersey Division of Revenue's website. Information can be found at Getting Registered
Step 1: If your business is a legal entity such as a corporation, limited partnership, or limited liability company, you must file formation or authorization documents for the public record. General partnerships and sole proprietors are not subject to this first requirement. <u>Starting a Corporation in New Jersey</u>
Step 2: Applies to all businesses. You must file Form NJ-REG to be registered for tax and employer purposes (Step 2). Online registration
Post a Beverage Tax Bond with the New Jersey Division of Taxation. The bond form is available on the Division of Taxation's website, <u>Beverage Tax Bond</u>
Apply for the Out-of-State Winery License with the New Jersey Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control. Information can be found at www.nj.gov/oag/abc/index.html
File the New Jersey Alcoholic Beverage Tax returns on a bi-monthly basis (every two months). Returns, schedules, and instructions are available on the Division of Taxation's website.
File New Jersey Sales and Use Tax returns. All licensees are required to collect and remit Sales and Use Tax on sales to New Jersey customers. Returns, schedules, and instructions are available on the Division of Taxation's website,
