## NJTA to hold public hearing on change in off-peak discount for E-ZPass users on Turnpike

**WOODBIDGE**, May 3, 2011 – The New Jersey Turnpike Authority will hold the first of three public hearings today on a proposal to eliminate the off-peak discount on the Turnpike for drivers who have E-ZPass accounts through agencies in other states.

The hearing will be held from 4:30 to 7:30 p.m. in the Hambletonian Room on the Pegasus Level of the Meadowlands Racetrack in East Rutherford.

The Turnpike Authority Board of Commissioners voted in March to hold three public hearings on the proposal to change the off-peak E-ZPass discount. The discount is now offered to all E-ZPass customers on the Turnpike. If the proposal is adopted, the discount would no longer be offered to drivers with non-New Jersey E-ZPass accounts.

The second hearing is scheduled for Thursday from 4:30 to 7:30 p.m. at the Turnpike Authority headquarters at 581 Main Street in Woodbridge.

The third hearing is scheduled for 4:30 to 7:30 p.m. on May 9 at the Camden County Community College Blackwood Campus, 200 College Drive, Blackwood, NJ.
