This notice announces the annual adjustments to the national average payment rates for CACFP meals and supplements served in child care centers, outside-school-hours care centers, at-risk afterschool care centers, emergency shelters, and adult day care centers. The rate for Lunch/Dinner does not include the cash-in-lieu of USDA Foods rate, which sponsors receive as additional assistance for each lunch or dinner served to participants.

The payment rates for the period July 1, 2018 - June 30, 2019 are:
