A. Docket No. QO20120750 – In the Matter of the Clean Energy Request for Qualifications of Offshore Wind Transmission Consulting Services for PJM State Agreement Approach Process.

Seeking approval from the Board to award a contract to retain a consultant to assist Board Staff in working with PJM on the development of PJM's offshore wind transmission request for proposals, and the review and evaluation of proposals from transmission developers.

C. Docket No. QO21010084 – In the Matter of Contract for Analyzing the Rate Impact of the Energy Master Plan.

The Energy Master Plan identified a set of goals and pathways for New Jersey to reach 100% clean energy by 2050, as directed by Governor Murphy in Executive Order No. 28. The EMP, and its associated modeling, considered the costs and benefits of the full energy system, but not the individual ratepayer impacts of such a transition. The Board will consider issuance of a Request for Quotations to procure a consulting firm to supplement the EMP and analyze the ratepayer impacts of a series of possible scenarios.

2. ENERGY

A. Docket No. GR20070501 – In the Matter of the Petition of Elizabethtown Gas Company to (1) Revise its Weather Normalization Clause Rate; (2) Revise the Clean Energy Program Component of its Societal Benefits Charge Rate; and (3) Revise its On-System Margin Sharing Credit.

The Board will consider Elizabethtown Gas Company's Weather Normalization Clause; Clean Energy Program; and its On-System Margin Sharing Credit rate adjustments. The parties have executed a stipulation for final rates, which if approved by the Board, will result in no change to customers' bills.

B. Docket No. ER20100628 – In the Matter of the Verified Petition of Jersey Central Power and Light Company for the Review and Approval of Costs Incurred for Environmental Remediation of Manufactured Gas Plant Sites Pursuant to the Remediation Adjustment Clause of its Filed Tariff ("2019 RAC Filing").

The Board will consider Jersey Central Power and Light Company's 2019 Remediation Adjustment Clause filing. The parties have executed a stipulation, which if approved by the Board, will result in a monthly decrease of \$0.09 for the typical residential customer.

C. <u>Docket No. ER20010090 – In the Matter of the Petition of Rockland Electric</u> <u>Company's Annual RGGI Surcharge True-Up Filings for 2019.</u>

The Board will consider Rockland Electric Company's 2019 RGGI True up filing. The parties have executed a stipulation, which if approved by the Board, will result in a \$0.82 decrease to the typical residential customer's monthly bill.

A. <u>Docket No.TO21010048 – In the Matter of Compliance with Executive Order 190 by</u> <u>Cable and Telecommunication Services Providers</u>.

This matter involves the review of plans by the State's cable television and telecommunications service providers to ensure compliance with the Executive Order 190 issued by Governor Murphy, which addresses continuation of internet and voice services during the continuation of the State of Emergency due to the pandemic.

A. <u>Docket No. WC21020108 – In the Matter of Donna Barone, on Behalf of Herself and</u> All Other Similarly Situated, Plaintiffs, vs. Aqua New Jersey, Inc., Defendant.

The Board will consider an Order by the Superior Court of New Jersey dismissing without prejudice and transferring a complaint alleging that Aqua New Jersey failed to provide water in December 2019 and January 2020 to the Board in order to determine if the Board wishes to invoke jurisdiction to conduct further proceedings in accordance with the Board's procedures, statutes and regulations. If the Board invokes jurisdiction, this complaint will be transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for further proceedings.
