A. Docket No. ER21050823 – In the Matter of the Verified Petition of Rockland Electric Company for Approval of Changes in Electric Rates, its Tariff for Electric Service, and its Depreciation Rates; and for Other Relief.

This matter involves a petition for a base rate increase filed by Rockland Electric Company. The proposed Board action is the first suspension of the proposed rates for four months to October 21, 2021, to allow the Board to investigate the just and reasonableness of the proposed rates.

A. Docket No. ER21020088 – In the Matter of the Petition of Atlantic City Electric Company to Reconcile and Update the Level of its Non-Utility Generation Charge and its Societal Benefits Charge (2021).

The Board will consider Atlantic City Electric Company's 2021 Non-Utility Generation Charge and Societal Benefits Charge rates. The parties have executed a stipulation, which if approved by the Board, will result in a monthly increase of \$1.36 for the typical residential customer using 679 kWh monthly.

B. <u>Docket Nos. BPU GR20060381 and OAL PUC 09629-2020 – In the Matter of the</u> <u>Petition of Elizabethtown Gas Company to Review its Periodic Basic Gas Supply</u> <u>Service Rate.</u>

The Board will consider Elizabethtown Gas Company's 2020 Basic Gas Supply Service rates. The parties have executed a stipulation for final rates that, if approved, will result in no changes in customers' monthly bills.

This matter relates to the Elizabethtown Gas Company's 2020 Energy Efficiency Rate true up. The parties have executed a stipulation, which if approved by the Board, will result in a monthly decrease of \$0.11 to the typical residential heating customer's bill.
