**B.** Docket No. GR22040253 – In the Matter of the Petition of South Jersey Gas Company for Approval of Increased Base Tariff Rates and Charges for Gas Service, Changes to Depreciation Rates and Other Tariff Revisions.

This matter involves a petition for a base rate increase filed by South Jersey Gas Company. The proposed Board action is the first suspension of the proposed rates for four months, to September 13, 2022, to allow the Board to investigate the just and reasonableness of the proposed rates.

**C.** Docket Nos. BPU EC19030317 and OAL PUC 12007-2019 – In the Matter of County of Cumberland, Petitioner v. Atlantic City Electric Company, Respondent.

The Board will consider a second extension of the deadline for the Board to render a final decision made by the Administrative Law Judge regarding Cumberland County v. Atlantic City Electric Company.

**A.** Docket No. ER22030198 – In the Matter of the Petition of Rockland Electric Company for Approval of an Infrastructure Investment Program, and Related Cost Recovery Mechanism.

The Board will consider designating a presiding commissioner for Rockland Electric Company's petition seeking approval of an Infrastructure Investment Program.

**B.** Docket No. GR21121256 – In the Matter of the Petition of Public Service Electric and Gas Company for Approval of the Next Phase of the Gas System Modernization Program and Associated Cost Recovery Mechanism ("GSMP II") (December 2021 GSMP II Rate Filing).

The Board will consider Public Service Electric and Gas Company's December 2021 GSMP II rate filing. The parties have executed a stipulation, which if approved by the Board, will result in an annual increase of \$13.40 for the typical residential customer using 172 therms in a winter month and 1,040 therms annually.

**C.** Docket No. ER22010027 – In the Matter of the Application of the Borough of Butler for an Order Approving a Levelized Energy Adjustment Clause (L.E.A.C.) for April 1, 2022 to June 30, 2022.

The Board will consider Butler Electric Company's Levelized Energy Adjustment Clause rates. The parties have executed a stipulation, which if approved by the Board, will result in a monthly decrease of \$38.42 for the typical residential customer using 1,000 kWh monthly.

The parties have executed a stipulation for provisional rates, which if approved by the Board, will result in a monthly decrease of \$3.52 for the average residential customer using 680 kWh monthly.
