## 2. ENERGY

N. Docket No. ER15010003 – In the Matter of the Federal Energy Items for 2015 – FERC Docket No. EL05-121-009 – In the Matter of the Settlement Proceedings Regarding FERC Order 494 Remand.

**Discussion:** On May 19, 2015, Deputy Attorney General T. David Wand updated the Board on the status of confidential settlement negotiations in <u>In re PJM interconnection</u>, FERC Docket No. EL05-121-005. This matter involved the allocation method used to calculate rate charges of approximately \$2 billion during the period from 2007 through January 2015. DAG Wand recapped the settlement positions presented to Judge Sterner at a settlement conference on April 17, 2015.

The next settlement conference is scheduled for June 8th and 9th. The Board discussed the various settlement proposals and instructed the DOL to continue to negotiate.

After appropriate motion, the Board reconvened to Open Session.

There being no further business before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.
