BY THE BOARD¹

The New Jersey Board of Public Utilities' (the "Board") SMARTSTART Buildings Program ("SSBP" or "SMARTSTART"), Direct Install Program and Pay-for-Performance Program collectively offers financial incentives to New Jersey property owners to encourage the installation of energy efficient products and technologies. Eligible applicants may receive incentives for a portion of the cost of installing energy efficient technologies such as lighting, HVAC, water heating or other measures in new or existing buildings.

By Order dated January 25, 2011, the Board adopted the OAL Initial Decision and Settlement Agreement (the "Settlement") fully executed on January 11, 2011 by and between the New Jersey Clean Energy Program ("NJCEP") and Cold Technology, Inc., the petitioner, to resolve all litigation involving 27 custom program applications. The Settlement terms provided that ShopRite-Eickhoff–Lumberton/Hainesport & ShopRite-Eickhoff-Delran (the "Applicant") would be allowed to receive an incentive payment calculated pursuant to the pre-July 23, 2009 incentive levels, and the terms further provided for a \$2,000,000 cap on the aggregate sum of all incentive payments. [See Order Adopting OAL Initial Decision and Settlement dated January 25, 2011, In the Matter of the Petition of Cold Technology, Inc. for Reconsideration of Staff's and Consultants' Evaluation of 27 Custom Applications Submitted Under the New Jersey SmartStart Buildings Program for Incentive Payments, Docket No. E010030244].

ShopRite Eickhoff – Lumberton, Hainesport; 1520 Route 38 East, Hainesport, NJ has submitted this application for a monetary amount of \$330,953.00 under the SMARTSTART Buildings Program. This rebate application, Docket Number EO11030148V has an annual estimated energy savings of 714,271 kWh and a demand reduction of 116 kW, and requests a rebate for various refrigeration energy efficiency measures, such as LED case lighting, variable frequency drives (VFDs), evaporator coil upgrades, electronic commutated motors, energy efficient

condensing units, and refrigeration controls at 1520 Route 38 East, Hainesport, NJ 08036. The rebate amount requested for the Lumberton, Hainseport project is consistent with the terms of the Settlement.

ShopRite Eickhoff – Delran, 1310 Fairview Blvd, Delran, NJ, has submitted this application for a monetary amount of \$339,492.00 under SMARTSTART. This rebate application, Docket Number EO11030149V, has an annual estimated energy savings of 720,545 kWh and a demand reduction of 118 kW, and requests a rebate for various refrigeration energy efficiency measures, such as LED case lighting, VFDs, evaporator coil upgrades, electronic commutated motors, energy efficient condensing units, and refrigeration controls at 1310 Fairview Blvd, Delran, NJ 08075. The rebate amount requested for the Delran project is consistent with the terms of the Settlement.

TRC, the Market Manager engaged by the Board to manage the NJCEP C&I energy efficiency programs, has submitted a certification that the incentives for which TRC now seeks approval to commit have been calculated in accordance with the program policies and procedures, and that the listed amounts are the true and accurate estimated incentives for which each applicant is eligible. Further, Applied Energy Group, in its role as the NJCEP Program Coordinator, has reviewed the applications and submitted a certification that the incentives for which TRC now seeks approval to commit have been calculated in accordance with the program policies and procedures, and that the listed amounts are the true and accurate estimated incentives for which TRC now seeks approval to commit have been calculated in accordance with the program policies and procedures, and that the listed amounts are the true and accurate estimated incentives for which each applicant is eligible. Based on the above, the Staff recommends that the Board approve the above referenced applications.
