BY THE BOARD1:

The New Jersey Board of Public Utilities' (the "Board") SMARTSTART Buildings Program ("SSBP" or "SMARTSTART"), Direct Install Program and Pay-for-Performance Program offer financial incentives to New Jersey property owners to encourage the installation of energy efficient products and technologies. Eligible applicants may receive incentives for a portion of the cost of installing energy efficient technologies such as lighting, HVAC, water heating or other measures in new or existing buildings.

Saker ShopRites, Inc., Freehold, NJ, has submitted an application for a monetary incentive in the amount of \$329,205 under the Pay-for-Performance program, for a project located at one of its stores, Hamilton Square ShopRite, at 1239 Highway 33, Hamilton, NJ. This rebate application, Docket Number EO11040242V, will be receiving an incentive of \$9,171 for the energy reduction plan (ERP); \$188,871 for certain measures (including installation of new high-efficiency rooftop units, new reciprocating compressors, new air-cooled condensing units, new high-bay T8 lighting fixtures and LED accent lighting, new reach-in refrigerators and freezers, envelope insulation upgrades, and installation of DANFOSE controls to manage all other recommended measures); and an estimated \$131,163 for the one year true up of its ERP. This application has an estimated 34% total energy savings above the base line and will save the customer an annual estimate of 1,354,812 kWh of electricity, an annual estimate of 879 MMBtu of natural gas, and an estimated annual energy cost savings of \$186,886.

TRC, the Market Manager engaged by the Board to manage the New Jersey Clean Energy Program C&I energy efficiency programs, has submitted a certification that the incentive for

which TRC now seeks approval to commit have been calculated in accordance with the program policies and procedures, and that the listed amount is the true and accurate estimated incentive for which the applicant is eligible. Further, Applied Energy Group, in its role as the NJCEP Program Coordinator, has reviewed the application and submitted a certification that the incentive for which TRC now seeks approval to commit has been calculated in accordance with the program policies and procedures, and that the listed amount is the true and accurate estimated incentive for which each applicant is eligible. Based on the above, the Staff recommends that the Board approve the above referenced application.

The Board <u>HEREBY APPROVES</u> the aforementioned application for the incentive amount requested and <u>AUTHORIZES</u> issuance of a standard commitment letter to the applicant identified above, setting forth the terms and conditions of this commitment.

- 6. Brief description of measures:
 - Install seventeen new, 2-25ton high-efficiency <u>rooftop units</u> to replace outdated ones.
 - Install twenty-two new, <u>reciprocating compressors</u> in 4 different racks.
 Specific areas to also be fitted with radiant floor heating to supply heating and improve efficiency of compressors.
 - Each new rack will be equipped with new <u>air-cooled condensing units</u> ranging from 817.5 to 978 MBH (capacity at 15° TD), all of which possess EC motors.
 - Install new <u>high-bay T8 fixtures</u> to replace T12 fixtures throughout, including aisles. Install <u>LED accent</u> lighting in specific areas.
 - Install new <u>reach-in refrigerators and freezers</u> with LED lighting and ECM motors
 - Upgrade to R24 insulated panels on all four walls, and R31+ insulation for roof
 - Install DANFOSE <u>controls</u> to manage all other recommended measures, including refrigeration, lighting, HVAC, defrost, case controllers, etc.
