#### BY THE BOARD:

On April 2, 2012, Carlos J. Pinto ("Petitioner"), filed a petition with the Board of Public Utilities ("Board"), on behalf of CJP Investments, LLC d/b/a Manus's Kitchen Bar & Sushi Lounge, requesting a formal hearing related to a billing dispute with Public Service Electric and Gas Company ("Respondent") for utility services rendered by Respondent.

After Respondent filed an answer, the Board transmitted this matter to the Office of Administrative Law ("OAL") as a contested case, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 et seq. on May 21, 2012. The matter was assigned to Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Michael Antoniewicz.

A hearing was initially scheduled for September 26, 2012, but was adjourned and rescheduled to October 15, 2012. At the hearing, the parties engaged in settlement negotiations and on November 16, 2012, a Stipulation of Settlement ("Stipulation") was submitted to ALJ Antoniewicz.

Pursuant to the terms of the Stipulation, the parties have agree to the following:

- 1. As of October 8, 2012, Petitioner had an account balance of \$45,526.89;
- 2. Respondent will credit Petitioner's account in the amount of \$2,000.00 leaving a balance of \$43,526.89;

- 3. Petitioner shall pay \$10,000.00 within ten (10) days from October 15, 2012, leaving a balance of \$33,526.89; and
- 4. Petitioner shall pay the balance in eighteen (18) equal monthly installments of \$1,862.00 plus current bills starting with the November 12, 2012 bill.

On November 19, 2012, ALJ Antoniewicz issued an Initial Decision finding that the settlement satisfied the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1, because it was voluntary, its terms fully disposed of all issues in controversy and it was consistent with the law.

Upon review of the record and the Stipulation of Settlement of the parties, the Board <u>HEREBY FINDS</u> that the parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by their signatures and that by the terms of the Stipulation of Settlement fully resolved all outstanding contested issues in this matter. The Board further <u>FINDS</u> the Settlement is consistent with the law

Accordingly, the Board <u>HEREBY ADOPTS</u> the Initial Decision in its entirety as if fully set forth herein.



### BEFORE MICHAEL ANTONIEWICZ, ALJ:

This matter concerns a billing dispute by petitioner Carlos J. Pinto against respondent Public Service Electric and Gas Company. The Board of Public Utilities transmitted this matter to the Office of Administrative Law, where it was filed May 21, 2012, for determination as a contested case pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 to -15 and

N.J.S.A. 52:14F-1 to -13. The hearing scheduled for September 26, 2012, was adjourned at respondent's request and rescheduled for October 15, 2012. At the hearing, the parties engaged in settlement discussions toward an amicable resolution of this matter. Subsequently, under letter dated November 12, 2012, counsel for respondent submitted the attached Stipulation of Settlement setting forth the terms of agreement.

I have reviewed the record and the settlement terms and FIND:


- 1. The parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by their signatures or their representatives' signatures.
- The settlement fully disposes of all issues in controversy and is consistent with the law.

I CONCLUDE that this agreement meets the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1 and that the settlement should be approved. I approve the settlement and, therefore, ORDER that the parties comply with the settlement terms and that these proceedings be concluded.

I hereby FILE my initial decision with the BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES for consideration.

This recommended decision may be adopted, modified or rejected by the BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES, which by law is authorized to make a final decision in this matter. If the Board of Public Utilities does not adopt, modify or reject this decision within forty-five days and unless such time limit is otherwise extended, this recommended decision shall become a final decision in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10.

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STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT

Public Service Electric and Gas Company, Respondent

This matter having been brought before the Office of Administrative Law by the Petitioner, Carlos J. Pinto/CJP Investments, LLC d/b/a Manus's Kitchen Bar & Sushi Lounge, ("Petitioner"), against Respondent Public Service Electric and Gas Company ("PSE&G" or "Respondent") for utility service rendered by PSE&G to the premises 90 Ferry Street, Newark, NJ, 07105 (the "Property") and the Parties having agreed to settle this matter, hereby set forth the terms and conditions of their settlement agreement as follows:

- 1. As of October 8, 2012, Petitioner had an account balance of \$45,526.89.
- PSE&G agrees to credit Petitioner's account for \$2,000.00, leaving a balance of \$43,526.89.
- Petitioner agrees to pay \$10,000.00 within ten (10) days from October 15, 2012, leaving a balance of \$33,526.89.
- Petitioner will pay the balance which will be in eighteen (18) equal monthly
  installments of \$1,862.00 plus current bills starting with the November 2012 bill.
