WHEREAS, casino licensee Harrah's Atlantic City Operating Company, LLC (Harrah's AC) is wholly owned by Caesars Entertainment Resort Properties, LLC (CERP), a Delaware limited liability company that is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Caesars Entertainment Resort Properties Holdco, LLC (CERP Holdco), a Delaware limited liability company that is a wholly-owned subsidiary of qualified holding company Caesars Entertainment Corporation(CEC); and

WHEREAS, the Casino Control Act at N.J.S.A. 5:12-85.1b and c provides that a casino licensee must establish the qualification of each holding company, intermediary company or subsidiary and each officer and director thereof; and

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2013, CERP and CERP Holdco (the Applicants) filed PRN 1821402 with the Division of Gaming Enforcement (Division) seeking a ruling from the New Jersey Casino Control Commission (Commission) finding the Applicants qualified as holding companies pursuant to the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Division filed a report dated July 3, 2014 concluding that it would not object to the requested rulings; and

WHEREAS, the Commission considered the entire record in this matter, together with the presentations of counsel, at its public meeting of July 9, 2014;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission that, based upon the reports of the Division and all other evidence presented to the Commission at the public meeting of July 9, 2014, the application of CERP and CERP Holdco for qualification as holding companies



of casino licensee Harrah's AC is hereby GRANTED based upon the findings and rulings specified herein.

FINDINGS and RULINGS

Based upon consideration of the entire record of these proceedings, the Commission enters the following findings and rulings:

1. The Applicants and their natural person qualifiers hereto have complied with all requirements regarding the submission of information necessary to the Commission and the Division to evaluate PRN 1821402;
2. The persons whose qualification needs to be established for purposes of the PRN 1821402 are Gary Loveman in his capacity as President, Donald Colvin in his capacity as Chief Financial Officer and Eric Hession in his capacity as Treasurer, each of whom has previously been found qualified by the Commission pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Act;
3. The Applicants have established compliance with *N.J.S.A. 5:12-82d(7)-(8)* and 85b;
4. The Applicants have established by clear and convincing evidence that that they possess the financial stability, integrity and responsibility and the good character, honesty and integrity required by *N.J.S.A. 5:12-84, 85.1* and 89; and
6. The Applicants, in view of the foregoing and the entire record of the proceeding, are each qualified as a holding company of Harrah's AC.

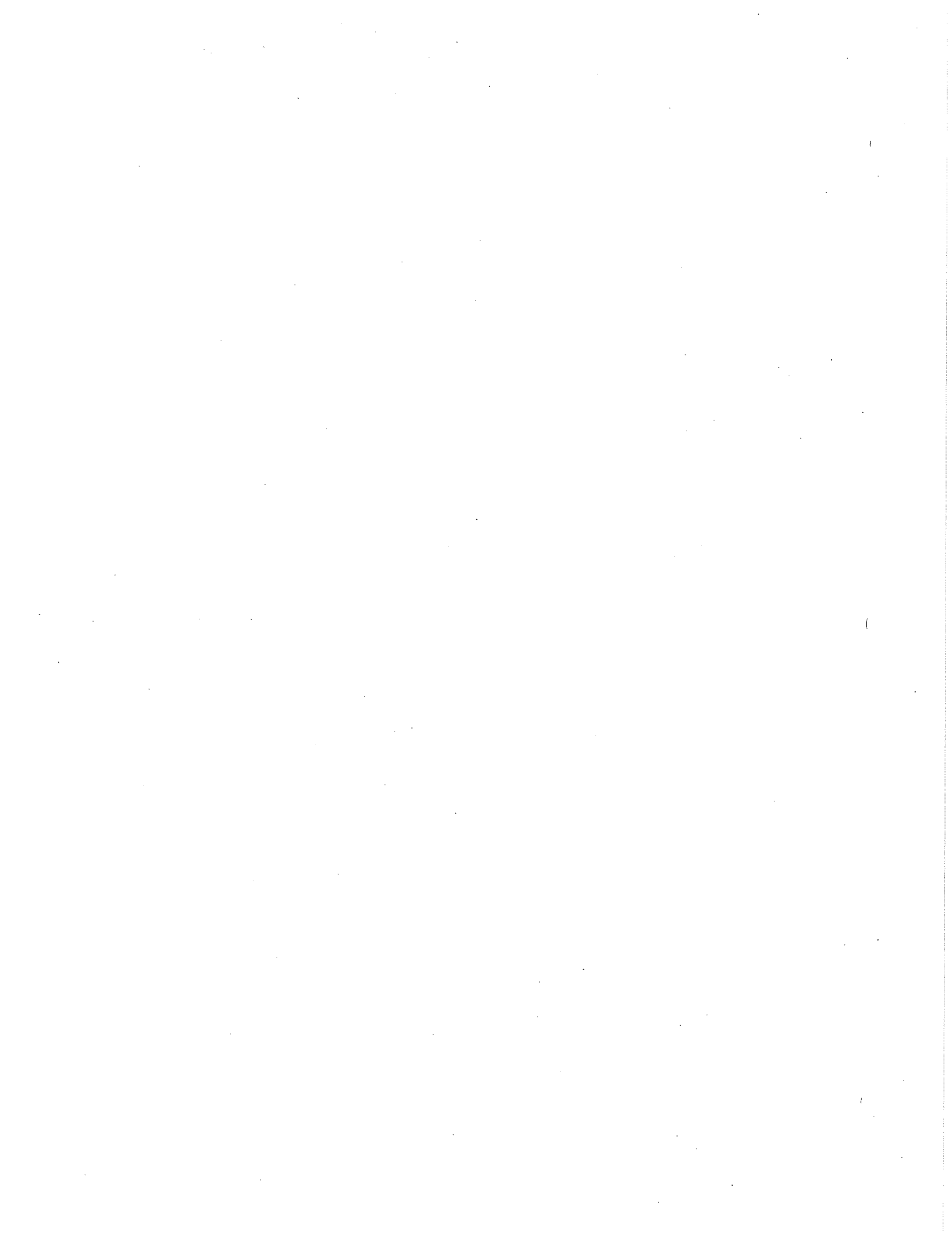
