The Division of Gaming Enforcement ("**Division**"), having objected to the initial application of Jean Marie West a.k.a. Jean Marie McMahon ("**Applicant**") for casino key employee license #009660-11; and the Division and Applicant having entered into a Stipulation of Settlement ("**Stipulation**") which was submitted to the New Jersey Casino Control Commission ("**Commission**"); and Applicant having been involved in no other matters inconsistent with licensure; and the Commission having considered this stipulation at its public meeting on January 13, 2016;

**IT IS** on this **13th** day of **January 2016**, **ORDERED** that the stipulation, which is incorporated herein by reference, is **APPROVED**, and the initial application for casino key employee license #009660-11 is **GRANTED**; and




