RESOLUTION OF THE NEW JERSEY CASINO CONTROL COMMISSION CONCERNING THE QUALIFICATION AND KEY LICENSURE OF DAMIAN R. TAYLOR TO SERVE AS CHIEF INFORMATION SECURITY OFFICER FOR GOLDEN NUGGET, LLC
