Campisi, Jr. ("**Appellant**") before the New Jersey Casino Control Commission ("**Commission**") pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 5:12-63(1)(b)(2)(v) seeking to appeal the May 28, 2015 Final Order of the Director of the Division of Gaming Enforcement ("**Respondent**") denying Appellant's request to be removed from the Exclusion List; and Oral Argument having been held on December 16, 2015; and the Hearing Examiner having considered all of the evidence, testimony and record from below *de novo* and having filed an Initial Decision; and the Hearing Examiner's Initial Decision having been filed with the Commission; and the Commission having considered the entire record of these proceedings at its public meeting of October 13, 2016,

RESOLUTION OF THE NEW JERSEY CASINO CONTROL COMMISSION CONCERNING THE JOINT PETITION OF CAESARS ENTERPRISE SERVICES, LLC; HARRAH'S ATLANTIC CITY OPERATING COMPANY, LLC; BOARDWALK REGENCY CORPORATION AND BALLY'S PARK PLACE, INC. FOR THE TEMPORARY LICENSURE OF PAUL BATEMAN AS A CASINO KEY EMPLOYEE PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 5:12-89e AS MANAGER, COLLECTIONS CAESARS ENTERPRISE SERVICES WITH A MULTI-CASINO ENDORSEMENT PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 5:12-91.1 AND A RESIDENCY WAIVER PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 5:12-89b(4). (PRN 2361601)

WHEREAS, Caesars Enterprise Services LLC, Harrah's Atlantic City Operating Company, LLC, Boardwalk Regency Corporation, and Bally's Park Place, Inc. (Petitioners) having filed a joint petition seeking approval of the New Jersey Casino Control Commission (Commission) for the issuance of a temporary casino key employee license pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-89e with a multi-casino endorsement pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-91.1 and a residency waiver pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-89b(4) to Paul Bateman as Manager, Collections Caesars Enterprise Services for a nine-month period pending plenary licensure;

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 5:12-89b(4) requires the holder of a key license to be a resident of the State of New Jersey, provided, however that the Commission may grant a waiver of such requirement for an applicant whose position will require him to be employed outside the State;

WHEREAS, the Division of Gaming Enforcement (Division) filed a letter report dated September 27, 2016, in which it indicated no objection to the issuance of a temporary casino key employee license to Mr. Bateman as




Manager, Collections Caesars Enterprise Services with a multi-casino endorsement before plenary licensure;

WHEREAS, the Division indicated no objection to granting a waiver of the residency requirement in its September 27, 2016, letter report;


WHEREAS, the Commission considered the entire record of the proceedings at its public meeting of October 13, 2016; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission that Paul Bateman be issued a temporary casino key employee license pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-89(e) as Manager, Collections Caesars Enterprise Services with a multi-casino endorsement pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-91.1. The Commission waives the residency requirement of N.J.S.A. 5:12-89b(4).
