exercise the powers of a Member of the Independent Audit Committee and of the Compliance Committee of DGMB and Resorts Digital, subject to the conditions contained in *N.J.S.A.* 5:12-85.1, 89b(1) and (2), and *N.J.A.C.* 13:69C-2.6.
