

## HSAC Needs Assessment Report Template Instructions

The report template includes pre-existing language provided by DCF, as well as text boxes and drop-down boxes where HSACs must select or input requested information related to their county's needs assessment findings. Each text box and drop-down box has specific instructions highlighted in red ink. General guidance is provided below.

### REPORTING CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

#### PART 1

**Executive Summary: HSACs will write a narrative that discusses and introduces the purpose of the report, emerging trends and findings from the needs assessment that will be highlighted in the report.**

**Introduction: DCF provides a narrative with an in-depth description regarding the purpose of the needs assessment and report.**

**County Description: HSACs will write a description of the county that includes information, such as demographics, geography, and education.**

**Needs Assessment Methodology: HSACs will write narratives for the following sections:**

- **County Profile Data** *(DCF provides content.)*
- **Approach for Prioritizing Needs** *(HSACs will provide content.)*
- **Focus Groups** *(DCF provides content.)*
- **Recruitment** *(HSACs will provide content.)*
- **Focus Group Participants** *(DCF provides content. HSACs will select appropriate answers from drop-down boxes. HSACs will also complete a table for the qualitative data collection.)*
- **Key Informant Interview** *(DCF provides content. HSACs will select/input appropriate responses.)*
- **Additional Data Collection Methodologies** *(HSACs will provide content.)*

#### PART 2

**Key Findings Across Needs: HSACs will write a narrative summary of the key findings that should describe:**

- **Trends Related to Scope Across Needs**
- **Significant Common Barriers to Services**
- **Significant or Common Trends in Impact of Needs on Subpopulations**
- **Overarching Local Considerations for Addressing Needs**
- **Trends (Differences or Similarities) Across Stakeholders' Perspectives**

**Key Findings-Basic Need Areas: DCF provides some contextual narrative language or instructions. HSACs will use their *Rutgers County Profile Data* and then select/input appropriate response (e.g. need area status, county name, year, etc.) via text box or drop-down box. HSACs will also provide summaries in the appropriate text box related to:**

- **Scope of the Need**
- **Nature of the Need**
- **Local Considerations for Addressing the Need** *(Required only if one of the 4 need area topics selected).*
- **Additional Notable Focus Group Trends for County Prioritized Need Area** *(If applicable).*
- **Input Survey Results**
