Day of Silence is a national studentled demonstration during which LGBTQIA+ students and allies all around the country take a vow of silence to protest the harmful effects of harassment and discrimination of LGBTQIA+ people in schools.

This observance is used to spread awareness about bullying and its impacts on lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender students. It originated in the 1990s, and participation quickly spread to over 100 colleges and universities in its first year.

Today, students, at all levels, participate in the day. Many choose to wear tape over their mouths or 'X' on their hands to further call attention to the movement. At the end of day, the **silence is typically broken with a rally** or speaking event, allowing all participants to end their **vow** together.
