The Department of Children and Families is pleased to announce that it may in the next twelve months issue a request for Proposal for a grant opportunity. This is not a commitment but a forecast of the potential business needs of DCF.

### **RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT SERVICES (RTC) INTENSITY OF SERVICES (IOS) FOR YOUTH WITH CO-OCCURRING MENTAL HEALTH AND INTELLECTUAL / DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY CHALLENGES**

The goal is to create a service environment with professional competencies to maintain an integrated treatment milieu that is clinically relevant to youth with co-occurring behavioral and intellectual / developmental disability challenges by providers via the “co-occurring” RTC IOS. Service requirements also will reflect the current CSOC initiative to reduce the use of seclusion and restraints, and to provide interventions thoroughly imbued with trauma and self-regulating care.

Opportunities are “forecasted” when funds are not yet formally available and are pending budgetary and discretionary spending approvals and federal agency program decisions. Once the forecasted opportunities are made final as a viable funding announcement, you will be able to complete and apply for consideration of funding within the timeframe of the Request for Proposal deadline date for any funding announcement you desire.
