The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Camden County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated February 6, 2019. The subject request proposes County Plan inclusion of the acceptance of waste type 25 (animal and food processing waste) at the Covanta/Camden County Energy Recovery Associates (CCERA) waste-to-energy facility in the City of Camden. Covanta has assured the County that they are able to accept, store, and process type 25 waste at the facility without any facility modifications and that the acceptance of the additional waste will not result in increase in air emissions.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, the modification of an existing facility including the acceptance of additional waste types can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of waste type 25 at the CCERA is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
