The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a July 13, 2020 request for administrative action to the Hudson County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan). This request for administrative action to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of revised hours of operation for waste acceptance and processing at the I.W.S. Transfer Systems of NJ, Inc. Transfer Station/Material Recovery Facility (TS/MRF) located at 375 Routes 1 & 9 South (Block 11702, Lot 2) in the City of Jersey City. Specifically, the revised hours of operation are included in the County Plan as follows:

- Acceptance & processing of waste: Monday through Saturday: 24 hours  
Sunday: 8:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, the inclusion of revised hours of operation can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of the revised hours of operation at the I.W.S. Transfer Systems of NJ, Inc.
