Dear Ms: Williams:

On June 15, 2010 the Department of Environmental Protection's Solid and Hazardous Waste Program received a request for an administrative action to modify the Salem County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) to allow the Pennsville Township Class C exempt facility to accept up to 10,000 cubic yards of leaves per year on Block 4801, Lot 5 and Block 4802, Lot 1 in Pennsville Township, Salem County. On September 5, 1984, the Salem County Board of Chosen Freeholders adopted an amendment to their County Plan to include Pennsville Township Compost Facility located on Block 548B, Lots 8 and 9 in the municipality of Pennsville Township, Salem County. This amendment was certified as approved by the Department on February 22, 1985. Please keep in mind that conditions i.-xiv. listed in N.J.A.C. 7:26A-1.4(a) 13 must be followed in order for these activities to be considered exempt.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11 (b) 3, the inclusion of a facility as a Class C exemption can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, this administrative action is hereby approved pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).

Pleased bear in mind that the reporting requirements listed under N.J.A.C. 7:26A-1.4(b) 4 are still applicable to all facilities except (3), (5), (7), (8), (9), and (10) listed at N.J.A.C. 7:26A-1.4(a).
