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INSTRUCTIONS FOR SIU-1 FORM

SUBMITTAL OF INFORMATION ON THIS FORM IS MANDATORY. The SIU-1 form is intended for use when applying for a NJPDES permit for discharge from a sewage treatment plant, when the plant does not have an existing permit requiring submittal of an annual pretreatment program report. It may also optionally be used to report proposed new or significantly changed discharges into the sewage treatment plant prior to an annual report submittal. Separate guidance is available for annual report submittals.

All local agencies receiving discharges from significant indirect users (SIUs) or which receive RCRA, CERCLA, or other remedial wastes must supply the following information annually for each SIU, RCRA or CERCLA facility. If more than one such facility discharges to the treatment works, you may copy applicable pages as needed.

Local agencies receiving wastewaters from multiple SIU, RCRA or CERCLA facilities may prefer to tabulate data and/or generate the data from existing database programs. Please contact the Bureau of Pretreatment and Residuals at (609) 633-3823 if you wish to use other submittal methods.

Federal Categorical pretreatment standards should be indicated as applicable to SIUs if the SIU has the potential to discharge into a local agency sewage treatment plant any wastewaters which are subject to "Pretreatment Standards for New Sources" or "Pretreatment Standards for Existing Sources", as applicable, unless the relevant standard consists entirely of a requirement to comply with General Pretreatment Standards (see 40 CFR 403.6). If in doubt, include known information and respond "To Be Determined" to question 4.b.

The **User ID#** may be assigned by the POTW. Its purpose is to assure that the remaining information is understood to refer to the correct indirect user if the user name changes, if multiple users have similar names (e.g., independent operating entities under a single corporation), or simply if pages are shuffled during preparation / transmission. Many, but not all users have Department-assigned "Masterfile Id" numbers which you may request and use if available.

The **Date Prepared** is the date that the POTW completed the form. If the POTW prepares multiple forms within one month which are submitted together, it is only necessary to fill this out on the first page of the submittal.
