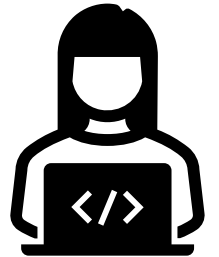
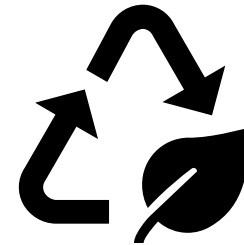
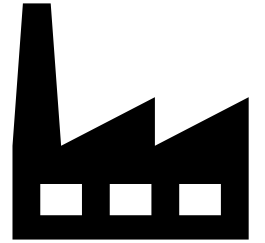


Environmental Stewardship Program

- Originally the Stewardship Program was completely administered by the NJDEP's Compliance and Enforcement programs.
- The new Environmental Stewardship Program will be a collaboration with the NJDEP's Compliance and Enforcement programs and the Bureau of Sustainability.



- When an inspector visits a facility they feel is a good candidate for the stewardship program, the inspector provides the facility with an informational flyer on the New Jersey Sustainable Business Registry.
- Inspectors input the recommendation for the stewardship program into NJEMS.



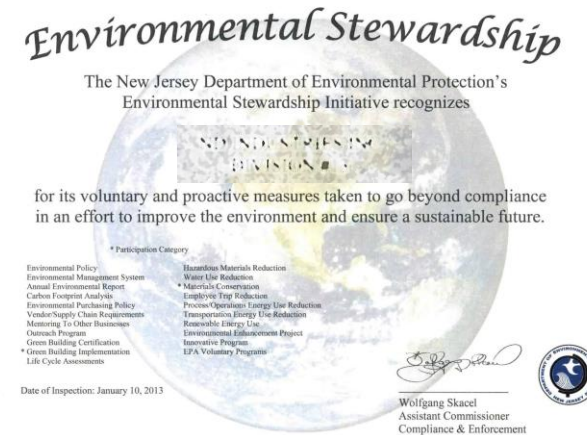
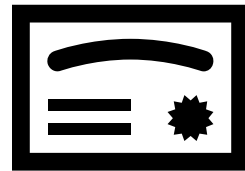
Initiated by Compliance Inspector

- BOS staff contacts the facility to explain the New Jersey Sustainable Business Registry and the Stewardship Program.
- The facility completes a Sustainable Business Registry profile and identifies Five Sustainable Actions/Practices One Measurable Environmental Benefit and One Cost Savings from a Practice.
- Then BOS will conduct a compliance review.



Application Processed by Sustainability

BOS staff will issue that facility with both:
Stewardship Certificate from the NJDEP
Certificate of Innovation in Sustainability
from the NJSBDC's Sustainable Business
Registry.
