



# Outdoor Women of New Jersey's Virtual Turkey Hunt Workshop

April 11-25, 2021



The Women's Virtual Turkey Hunt Workshop is part of the NJ Division of Fish and Wildlife's "Outdoor Women of New Jersey" (O.W.N.J.) program. O.W.N.J. workshops are designed to provide **women 18 years of age or older** with a welcoming environment in which to learn outdoor skills. These workshops are for you if you are a newcomer to the outdoors, an outdoor enthusiast who wants to learn new skills, or someone who wishes to network with other outdoor enthusiasts.

**Workshop Overview:** In partnership with National Wild Turkey Federation's Women in the Outdoors (NWTF WITO), this workshop will take place over three weeks with each week focusing on a different aspect of turkey hunting. Weekly topics may include turkey biology, hunting regulations, equipment and techniques, scouting, planning your hunt, and turkey calling. There will be weekly meetups to discuss the week's content, ask questions and hear from experienced turkey hunters.
