Caranax hippos



Description:

- deep body
- front of head steep
- fins often yellowish
- juveniles have 5 dark vertical bars down sides oval black spot at edge of opercle and at base of pectoral fin

Size:

• up to 5 feet

Range:

 Nova Scotia down entire Atlantic coast; northern Gulf of Mexico to Uruguay


Facts:

- prey on a variety of fish, invertebrates and shrimp
- fish grunt and snort
- spawn early March to early September
- spawning occurs offshore of southeast Atlantic coast and in Gulf Stream where eggs
- ride the currents
- larvae use estuaries as nurseries
- most juveniles inhabit sea grass beds
