

Naked Goby

Gobiosoma bosci



• Description:

- greenish brown above
- pale below
- large eyes set close together on top of head
- rounded tail
- 9 to 11 regular vertical bars starting behind head ending just before tail
- entirely unscaled
- ♦ 2 separate dorsal fins
- fused pelvic fins

Size:

♦ up to 2.5 inches

Range:

 New York to Texas; except for extreme southern Florida


Facts:

- prefer protected coastal waters, tidal fresh water, vegetation and sea grass beds
- use fused pelvic fins as suction cups to cling to shells and rocks
- ♦ bottom dwellers
- resembles a lizard
- goby family contains more species than any other family of fish (2000+ documented)
- solitary reclusive fish
- use debris like cans and bottles as safe havens
- ♦ lay eggs in empty clam/oyster shells
- males guard the nest
