

Rainwater Killifish

Lucania parva



Description:

- straw colored head and body
- sometimes dark blotches on sides
- each scale darkly outlined
- males will have a yellowish dorsal fin, dark spot near base, fin becomes orange near rear
- pelvic and anal fins are orange or yellowish with orange edges

Size:

• up to 1.5 inches

Range:

 Massachusetts to the northern Gulf of Mexico to the Florida Keys and northeastern Mexico

Facts:

- eats larval crustaceans, mosquito larvae, small worms and mollusks
- likes vegetated quiet waters
- ♦ tolerates a wide range of salinity
- most often found in slow-moving backwaters and marshes
- will remove external parasites from other members of its species
