

# Summer Flounder

## Paralichthys dentatus



### **Description:**

- many ocelli (dark eye-like spots) present; 5 large and consistently placed
- left eved flounder
- sharp, well developed teeth
- flat, rounded body
- slightly pointed tail fin
- both eyes locate on the top side of the head
- brown coloration on top and white on the bottom

### Size:

• up to 37 inches and 26 pounds

### Range:

Maine to northern Florida


#### **Facts:**

- spawn in late summer to mid winter in deep coastal ocean waters
- move inshore in spring where they remain until late fall
- (i.e. along beaches, estuaries and bays)
- live up to 20 years
- most important flounder along Atlantic coast for commercial and recreational fishing
- change color to blend in with environment
- commonly known as fluke
