Applications must be postmarked by **Thursday, September 30, 2021**, to be eligible for the lottery. There is **no fee** associated with applying for the lottery. Applicants must be 10 years of age or older to apply. A person may only submit **one** application but may select multiple hunt days they wish to be entered into a drawing for. <u>Application will be voided if it includes a name that has been entered more than once.</u> After the selection process, waterfowl hunters awarded a blind reservation will receive an email by **Friday, October 8** indicating they have been selected to arrive the morning of their respective date(s) to draw for a blind.

HUNT SITE INFORMATION

All gates to the impoundments located on the Tuckahoe WMA (Tuckahoe Section) will be closed one week (seven days) prior to the beginning of the South Zone Duck Season Splits (two segments), totaling 74 days. During this restricted period, there shall be no hunting from or adjacent to the impoundment roadways, exception for the hunting of waterfowl on days designated by the New Jersey Division of Fish and Wildlife. During the south zone duck season, hunting will be limited to three days per week as designated by the NJ Division of Fish and Wildlife. Hunting hours will be ½ hour before sunrise to 12:00pm.

- 1. <u>Report Times:</u> Individuals successfully selected for a blind reservation must check in three (3) hours before sunrise to be considered for the hunt day, or the blind reservation is forfeited and eligible to be claimed in the second lottery. Hunters not awarded a blind may arrive to be on standby in second lottery for eligible vacant blind(s) not claimed.
- 2. All sites require moderate physical exertion to access blinds. It is highly recommended that hunters plan to utilize small boats and/or kayaks to access blind sites from parking locations. For all hunt sites, **BRING ONLY WHAT YOU CAN CARRY AND/OR FLOAT IN.** Blind location (5) will be located near dike for easier access for hunter(s) needing accommodations.
- 3. Hunting from banks or dikes is NOT allowed. Hunters that opt not to hunt from the Division maintained blind must stay within 150' of assigned blind.
- 4. No hunting is allowed within 450' seaward of the dike around the impoundments (see map).
- 5. After blind selection is complete, the gates to the impoundments will be open and hunters will be allowed to park proximate to their hunting location. Blinds will accommodate a maximum of four (4) hunters.
- 6. Upon vacating a blind or hunting area, groups may not return.
- 7. Hunters must complete a paper exit survey at the end of the hunt day, or electronically by scanning a QR code to complete survey on their mobile device. Failure to complete exit survey may preclude hunter eligibility of hunt days for the remainder of the hunting season and/or subsequent seasons.
- 8. Decoys will be available for loan to groups. This Division loaned equipment must be turned in to onsite Division staff by 2:00 PM or will be deemed as stolen state property. Failure to return equipment may preclude the violator from eligibility of hunt days for the remainder of the hunting season and/or subsequent seasons.

Youth hunters 10 to 15 years of age are expected to have their valid youth firearm license. Waterfowl hunters 16 years of age and older are expected to have a valid New Jersey hunting license, HIP certification, Federal Migratory Bird Hunting Stamp and NJ Waterfowl Stamp in their possession. In addition to special site regulations, all migratory bird seasons, possession limits, and general regulations are in effect. Any violation of any law or WMA regulation may result in immediate dismissal from the hunt.

WHEN FILLING OUT YOUR WATERFOWL HUNT APPLICATION PLEASE PAY SPECIAL ATTENTION TO THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

Applications must be post-marked by the application deadline date. No applications will be accepted without the correct post-mark. Hand delivered, faxed, or e-mailed applications must be submitted by the deadline date. Any application received with the correct post-mark more than one week post-deadline will not be considered for the drawing. The Division of Fish and Wildlife is not responsible for lost or misrouted mail.

An email address is mandatory. Notification of successful applicants for regular season hunt dates will be emailed only after completion of the drawing by Friday, October 8. Notification of successful applicants for Youth and Military Hunt Dates will be notified a week prior.

All cancellations must be made through the Southern Region Office. Please call 856-629-1014.

There are no transfer of successfully awarded blind reservations.
