

PUBLIC HEARING ANNOUNCEMENT

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Town of Morristown has contacted the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres Program, proposing an amendment to its Recreation and Open Space Inventory (ROSI). The purpose of the amendment is to remove from the ROSI the property identified as Block 2901, Lot 1 on the official tax map of the Town of Morristown and located at 90 Lake Road. It is the Town's claim that this property has never been held for park purposes but rather for solid waste then recycling purposes. Regardless of Green Acres' decision on this matter, the County's Patriot's Path easement will continue to run adjacent to Lake Road.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:36-25.3(h)2v, a hearing to obtain public comment on this request will be held virtually on **February 23, 2021 at 6:30 pm**.
