All points through which any given line passes are at the same level and their heights above mean sea level are indicated by the figures on the line. The line is not drawn for any line that is not shown, 10 or 20 feet. Figures on any line show the actual elevation of the surface at a point indicated by a small cross. Figures on the ground indicate the depth of water at mean low tide.
