



NOTE.—The curved lines are level lines drawn on the earth's surface. All points through which any given line passes are at the same level and their heights above mean sea level are shown by the figures on the line. The rise or fall from any line to the next is as the figures show, and is 10 feet. If there are no figures the level is the same as the level of the line above or below it. Figures on blue ground indicate the depth of water at mean low tide.
