NOTE: The contour lines are level lines drawn on the earth's surface. All points through which they pass are at the same level and their height above sea level is shown by the figures on the line. The rise or fall from any one to the next is as the figures will show. 20-foot figures are not on the line but the actual elevation of the surface at a point indicated by a small cross.
