

A TOPOGRAPHICAL MAP OF THE VALLEY OF THE PASSAIC

WITH THE COUNTRY EASTWARD TO NEWARK AND SOUTHWARD TO THE RARITAN RIVER

From Original Surveys and Levelings, supplemented by various Local Surveys,
based on the Triangulation of the U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey.

Scale: 1 Mile to an Inch.

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NOTE: The curved lines are level lines drawn on the earth's surface. All points through which they pass are at the same level and their height above mean sea level is shown by the figures on the line. The rise or fall from any line to the next is as the figures will show. 20 feet in high sections and 10 feet in low country. Figures not on any line show the actual elevation of the surface of a point indicated by a small cross.
