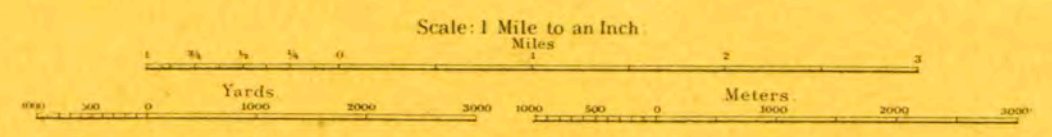


ATOPOGRAPHICAL MAP

NOTE: The curved lines are level lines drawn on the earth's surface. All points through which they pass are at the same level and their height above mean sea level is shown by the figures on the line. The rise or fall from one line to the next is as the figures will show. 20 feet in hills, portions and 10 feet in the low country. Figures not on any line show the actual elevation of the surface at a point indicated by a small cross. Figures in water indicate depth at mean tide.
