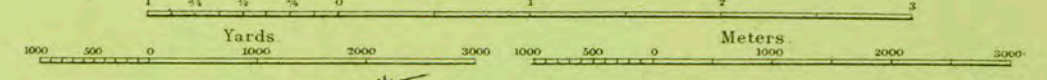


A TOPOGRAPHICAL MAP
