

Important Notice Regarding the NJ Community Forestry Council (CFC) Meeting on Thursday, May 13, 2021 In light of the Governor Murphy's issuance of Executive Order 107, all State Agencies have been strongly encouraged to conduct all public meetings subject to the Open Public Meetings Act exclusively using communications equipment (e.g., telephonic conference call-in connections, internet streaming, etc.) for the foreseeable future without providing a physical meeting place. Additionally, P.L. 2020, c.11 passed on 3/20/2020 allows public bodies to conduct meetings and provide notice by electronic means during periods of emergency. Therefore, the CFC meeting scheduled to take place at the Forest Resource Education Center in Jackson New Jersey, will now be held as a virtual meeting.
