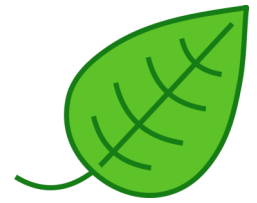




# PROJECT LEARNING TREE

- \*Differentiated instruction

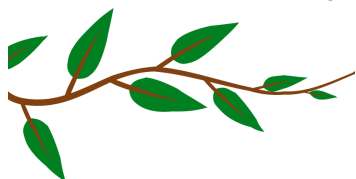
