

Hacklebarney State Park Fishing 2019

Trout Fishing Regulations: Black River

January 1st—March 17th

Minimum size : 9 inches

Daily limit: 4

March 18th—April 6th at 8am

Catch and release

April 6th at 8am—May 31st

Minimum size: 9 inches

Daily limit: 6

June 1st—December 31st

Minimum size: 9 inches

Daily limit: 4

Bait: No bait restrictions.

Both live and artificial bait can be used.

Stocking Dates (No fishing closures):

April 18 & 25

May 2, 9, 16, 23

All Brook Trout must be immediately released unharmed as Hacklebarney State Park is included in the Brook Trout Conservation Zone.

Fishing Regulations for Wild Trout Streams: Rhinehart and Trout Brooks

January 1st—April 6th at 8am

Catch and release only

April 6th at 8am—September 15th

No minimum size

Daily limit: 2 Brown or Rainbow Trout combined

September 16th—December 31

Catch and release only

Bait: Artificial lures only.

No more than 3 hook points in total, all barbless.

Possession or use of bait, or synthetic bait with bait scent prohibited.

All Brook Trout must be immediately released unharmed as Hacklebarney State Park is included in the Brook Trout Conservation Zone.

Rainbow and Brown Trout, no minimum size.
