1. Only one application for each licensed vehicle shall be accepted. Permits are issued for fishing purposes only. Vehicles shall be equipped with 4-wheel drive and shall be registered or leased to the applicant/permittee who shall be 18 years of age or older.
2. The applicant/permittee shall sign the application. Permits are not transferable. Applicant/permittee shall be responsible for the actions of any driver operating the permit vehicle on the beach.
3. Mailed application shall be accompanied by credit card information or a check or money order made payable to "Treasurer, State of New Jersey". No cash shall be accepted through the mail. Mail application to Bass River State Forest, 762 Stage Road Tuckerton, NJ 08087. **Please send a self addressed stamped envelope with the application and payment.**
4. Permit decals shall be securely applied on the left (driver's side) of the front and rear bumpers so as to be clearly visible.
5. Mobile sport fishing vehicle permit replacement fee is \$25. Requests for replacement decals shall be accompanied by a paid receipt and both of the "old" decals, regardless of condition.
6. Permit is valid from January 1st to December 31st inclusive.
7. From May 15th through September 15th, vehicles are prohibited on the beach to protect nesting colonies of endangered shorebirds.
8. Persons not "actively engaged in fishing" shall leave the beach "Actively engaged in fishing" includes (a) travel to and from a fishing location; (b) set up time; (c) use of the vehicle for food, beverages, sanitary facilities, etc.; and (d) stow gear when fishing activity ceases.
9. Vehicles shall use the marked access roads only and stay within the designated beach areas. Vehicles shall keep off the dunes and vegetated areas.
10. Maximum speed permitted on the beach is 10 mph.
11. Permittee shall be liable for any damage to persons or property resulting from the use of his/her vehicle within the natural area.
12. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited. Violations of park rules and regulations shall be cause for permit privileges to be suspended without a refund.
13. The applicant/permittee, by use of this permit, agrees to comply with all park rules and regulations and shall be responsible for full compliance with these rules and regulations for himself/herself and for the conduct of all vehicle occupants.

Mobile Sport Fishing Vehicle Permit Rules

Permit Use

- Valid from January 1st to December 31st
- From May 15th through September 15th, vehicle access to beach prohibited in order to protect endangered shorebirds
- Non-transferable to another vehicle
- Permit holder is responsible for the actions of any driver operating the permit vehicle on the beach
- All drivers must be 18 years of age or older
- Permit holder is liable for any damage to people or property resulting from the use of permit vehicle on the beach
- The area superintendent reserves the right to close the beach or sections to vehicles due to high tides, erosion, or other emergencies.
- No more than 75 vehicles allowed on the beach

Vehicle must carry mandatory equipment

- Fishing equipment & bait/tackle for each person over 12 years of age.
- Trash bag to carry your trash out with you
- Tire gauge
- Spare tire
- Workable jack & board/support for jack in sand (3/4 in. x 12x12 in. plywood square minimum size)
- Tow chain/snatch line
- Shovel
- Flashlight
- Fire extinguisher
- Auto first aid kit
- Minimum of 1/4 tank of fuel
- Current tide chart recommended

Parking

- Avoid obstructing other vehicles
- Avoid incoming tide
- Avoid moisture/salt spray on windshield and engine compartment
- Part at right angles to water line.
- Keep vehicles in good repair and not leaking fluids

Not permitted

- X Alcoholic beverages
- X Camping or temporary tent/shelter
- X Fires
- X Gray water discharge
- X Pets April 1 to September 15
(pets *allowed on a leash* September 16-March 31)
- X Conduct or language which disturbs other beach goers

Driving on the Beach

- The only beach access point is at 15th St. North
- Prior to entering beach, reduce tire pressure to avoid getting stuck
- Comply with the 10 mph speed limit
- When driving yield to the right of oncoming traffic
- Use caution to avoid people, fishing equipment and other items on the beach
- Stay within the designated beach areas
- Keep off the dunes and vegetated areas
- Permit holders may not use or transport unauthorized equipment or flotation devices such as rafts, boats, inflatable boats, surfboards, or windsurf sailboats.

Fishing

- All persons over 12 years of age must have personal fishing gear (rod, reel, line, hooks and bait/lures).
- Permit use restricted to "fishing" and related activities such as travel to and from fishing location, setting up, stowing gear, and the like.
- Shall be actively engaged in fishing activities when on the beach between midnight and 4:00 am.

Decals

- Apply securely to the left (driver's side) of the front and rear bumpers
- Must be properly affixed to the vehicle when on the beach
- Mobile sport fishing vehicle permit replacement fee is \$25
- For replacement decals, include a paid receipt and both of the "old" decals, regardless of condition.

Violations of park rules and regulations shall be cause for permit privileges to be suspended without a refund.

The area superintendent may suspend a permit for up to 90 days if found in violation of any law, rule, or regulation. No refunds will be given if a permit is suspended.

All motor vehicles operated on lands under the jurisdiction of the State Park Service and all park users shall be subjected to the Motor Vehicle Laws of the State, N.J.S.A. 39-1 et. seq., and the New Jersey State Park Service Administrative Code, NJAC 7:2-et. seq.
