Summary: FIBI517 is a sentinel site which is sampled every three years for Headwaters IBI monitoring to evaluate assemblage changes through time and to better understand natural variability. This site was rated "good" in 2015. The Beerskill decreased in score and rating from 2013 to 2015; however, this was mainly due to not capturing any common crayfish in 2015. This site stills contains a healthy population of sensitive fish and salamanders. Beerskill is located in a highly forested watershed and protected within the Stokes State Forest.
