- Storage Study: Mott MacDonald was selected through a competitive process. A kickoff meeting was
 held in late May, and an initial screening workshop in July. The workshop concept was discussed, as
 well as next steps in the project. A second workshop is scheduled for February 2022. A website has

- DRBC is working on a few projects of interest to the WMAC:
 - Water Audit Trend Analysis 2012-2020
 - A groundwater availability analysis based on a recently published water withdrawal projection report.
 - Authoring multiple chapters of the Technical Report for the Delaware Estuary and Basin (TREB) which is developed every five years by the Partnership for the Delaware Estuary.
- DRBC is operational with staff working remotely, with some staff returning to the office intermittently. Return to office plans are evolving based on available data and information.
