#### SYNOPSIS

Petitioner challenged the Board's residency determination that her sister, E.O., was not entitled to a free public education in the District.

The ALJ concluded that petitioner met her burden of proof under *N.J.S.A. 18A:38-1b(1)* that E.O. was domiciled in the District; that petitioner was supporting her *gratis*; and that E.O.'s parents living in Peru were incapable of supporting her. The ALJ concluded that E.O. was entitled to a free public education in the District.

The Commissioner adopted the Initial Decision as his own and ordered the Board to continue to admit E.O. into its public school system free of charge.
