The record of this matter, including the audiotape of the hearing conducted on petitioner's application for emergent relief, and the Order of the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) have been reviewed.

Upon review, for the reasons expressed in the Order and at hearing, the Commissioner concurs with the ALJ that petitioner is not entitled to the relief she seeks. The Commissioner also concurs that there appears to be no need for further proceedings in this matter, and he notes that neither party objected when the ALJ expressed that view at hearing.
